



**THE CHAMPAGNE**  
**"Win and You're In Breeders' Cup**  
**Juvenile Division"**  
**\$500,000**  
**(Grade I)**  
**(Up to \$52,000 NYSBFOA)**

**FOR TWO YEAR OLDS** Lasix not allowed within 48 hours of post time pursuant to HISA Rule 4212. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,500 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The Champagne has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the Champagne will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2025 running of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Division. The nominated winner will also be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived for the 2025 Breeders' Cup Juvenile or will receive a credit equal to the 2025 Breeders' Cup Juvenile pre-entry and entry fee amount towards any other 2025 Breeders' Cup Championship race. All horses will be entitled to receive a travel stipend if travelling from a base located outside the state of California. To be eligible for the 2025 Breeders' Cup World Championships held at the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on October 31 and November 1st, 2025, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (Local Standard Time at the designated place of pre-entry) on Monday, October 20, 2025. Winner must be nominated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge rewards. All Breeders' Cup Challenge Races and Breeders' Cup World Championship races are to be run Lasix free and in accordance with Breeders' Cup Limited rules as they may be published and/or amended from time to time, which rules are hereby expressly incorporated by this reference. All runners nominated to Challenge races and all Challenge winners are subject to out of competition testing by the Horseracing Integrity and Welfare Unit on behalf of the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (or their respective designees). Breeders' Cup Limited reserves the right in its sole discretion to postpone, discontinue, amend or change the conditions of all or any part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge "Win & You're In" race program. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2026 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The Champagne has also been selected as one of the races in the Kentucky Derby Championship Series "Prep Season". The winner of the Champagne will be awarded 10 points, the second place finisher 5 points, the third place finisher 3 points, the fourth place finisher 2 points and the fifth place finisher 1 point. 122 lbs. Preference to start will be determined by Graded Stakes winners, Graded Stakes placed runners, non-restricted Stakes winners, total earnings. The New York Racing Association to add The Champagne Challenge Cup, to be won three times, not necessarily consecutively, by the same owner before becoming his or her property. The owner of the winner will also receive a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey.
