SIPPIN PRETTY rushed the gate in reaction to rivals doing so alongside just after MYTHICAL broke open her stall door and went on through, broke out at the start bumping IRON ORCHARD into CARMEL COAST, chased two to three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong seizing command seventy yards from home then edged away in the late going to prevail. GOODALL raced five to six paths off the rail in close aim of the top pair, tucked four wide through the turn and advanced under coaxing nearing the quarter pole to take over the front swinging four then three wide into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole, dug in under lone threat to the outside and was caught seventy yards from the finish, ran on clear of the rest to procure the place honors. A FINE CHARDONNAY rushed the gate when MYTHICAL broke open the stall door prior to the start, broke out at the start and was corrected, chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch detached at the tail of the field, tucked four wide through the turn and came under urging near the seven-sixteenths marker, went out nine to ten wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to secure the show honors. SNEAKY GOOD stumbled at the start recovering outwards and taking over the lane of TOMMY JO, chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn coming under encouragement midway, angled four wide at the head of the stretch, stayed on one paced to the finish. CARMEL COAST rushed the gate prior to the start when inspired by MYTHICAL just prior, got

bumped after the start by IRON ORCHARD due to pressure from SIPPIN PRETTY, chased three then two wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and weakened. PEACH TIE rushed the gate prior to the start in the wave of rushes just after MYTHICAL broke open her door, chased four paths off the rail down the backstretch between foes, got forced to briefly steady when CARMEL COAST backed up in front with seven-sixteenths to run, raced two to three wide through the turn and then six to seven wide into upper stretch and tired. TESSELLATE rushed the gate prior to the start, broke out at the start and was corrected, chased five then four wide under urging from the five-sixteenths, swung six wide into upper stretch and tired. MYTHICAL grew fractious and broke open the stall door prior to the start and then went on through without the rider but was a strong grip by the assistant starter, who did a great job to maintain his charge, got coaxed from the gate at the start and led briefly before pressing the pace of IRON ORCHARD from the outside four then three wide coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, swung three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. IRON ORCHARD rushed the gate prior to the start when MYTHICAL broke through the gate, then got bumped at the start by SIPPIN PRETTY and in turn bumped CARMEL COAST, established the front near the five furlong marker and showed the way in hand three then two wide under pressure coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, yielded the front and spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. TOMMY JO brushed the off side stall at the start when off half a beat slow and lost her lane to SNEAKY GOOD, chased five then four wide under coaxing from three furlongs out, went eight to nine wide into upper stretch and tired.
