GOSGER bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked along the inside, tipped three wide to take aim outside of the top pair entering the lane, bid at the furlong grounds and drove past. BRACKET BUSTER set the pace as an outer rival applied stern pressure, dueled with that bidder turning for home, fought on inside of a pair of foes in upper stretch as an outer GOSGER ranged up, but got outkicked by that one in the final furlong and was second best. PRAETOR pressed two wide, bid and sparked a duel turning for home, vied between rivals as an outer foe joined the fray in upper stretch, but faded in the final furlong then lasted for show. HYPNUS stalked three deep, came under rousing to maintain pressure outside of the top pair turning for home, but failed to do so while getting floated to the four path entering the lane, yet sustained a chase in the final furlong, issued a re-bid for show in the final furlong but failed to reel in that tiring rival. BULLARD bumped with an outer foe leaving the gate, laid off of the pace in the three path, but came under urging in the four path around the far turn, lacked a response spinning to the five path into the lane, shifted inwardly and ran on mildly. NATIVE RUNNER was bumped between horses at the start, trailed in the two path and made little impact. HARD AS LIFE broke in the air and spotted the rest multiple lengths at the start, saved ground off of the pace but tired.
